If a student is absent from school for an extended period of time, it is important for us to know the reason (i.e. travelling out of the country, illness etc), and the expected date of return.

According to the Ministry of Education any student in grades one to eight who is absent from school for 15 or more consecutive school days must be removed from the school register unless the following criteria are met:

- 1. Written confirmation of absence from parents/guardians
- 2. An expected date of return
- 3. Assignments have been provided to the student (please contact your child's teacher)

Junior and Senior kindergarten students absent for 15 or more school days will be removed from the school register as these are not mandatory attendance grades.
